Match Course of Fire:

Match 1: 100 yds. 25 shots plus unlimited sighters in 25 min.

Match 2: 50 yds. 25 shots plus unlimited sighters in 25 min.

Match 3: 100 yds. 25 shots plus unlimited sighters in 25 min.

Match 4: 50 yds. 25 shots plus unlimited sighters in 25 min.

Match 5: Aggregate of Match 1 plus Match 3

Match 6: Aggregate of Match 2 plus Match 4

Match 7: Grand aggregate (matches 1-6)

Targets: 50 IBS 50 yd, Rimfire 100 yd: IBS Hunter Rifle

Rifle Classes: Sporter: Any factory rifle, factory barrel and stock, any scope, and any trigger (except Anschutz, Remington 40x, or Cooper will be assigned custom class. Custom: All other rifles

Rules:

1. All rifles shot from bench
2. Two piece rest only
3. Shooters MUST be at range by 9:45am for safety and range operations briefing
4. Wind flags permitted on your bench or in your shooting lane (must not interfere with other shooters)

Entry:

1. Entry fee is \$25.00
2. Match will be limited to 30 shooters (3 relays on 10 benches).
3. Early registration will be accepted until 30 shooter limit is reached.
4. Match day registrations: if shooting positions are still available will be squadded in remaining positions on first come first serve basis.

Prizes:

80% of entry fees will be paid out in prizes for all 7 matches in each rifle class. The prize pool will be apportioned to each rifle class based on the number of entries. Will pay first, second, and third places on grand aggregate only. Will pay first place only on other six matches.

Scoring:

1. Scoring will be done by official match scorers. Competitors will be required to hang their targets and bring to the scoring table after each match.
2. No competitor will be permitted at the scoring table.
3. Challenges may be made at a cost of \$1.00 per challenge.
4. Targets and Scores will be available to competitors after each match is complete.

There will be a 1 ½ hour lunch break to go somewhere or bring your own lunch.
